




Plate M.1. Site 4-M-1 general view.






Plate M.2. Site 4-M-2(6), type RF05.




Figure M.3. Site 4-M-3 (scale 1:500).






Figure M.5. Site 4-M-25 (scale 1:500).




Figure M.5. Site 4-M-28 (scale 1:500).




Figure M.6. Site 4-M-35 (scale 1:500).




Plate M.17. Site 4-M-41, setting, type CS09.




Figure M.7. Site 4-M-47 (scale 1:1000).






Figure M.8. Site 4-M-52 (scale 1:500).




Figure M.9. Sites 4-M-53 and 4-M-145 (scale 1:2000).








Plate M.36. Site 4-M-59 (2) wall? type ~LN02.



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


Figure M.13. Site 4-M-79 (scale 1:500).










Plate M.52. Site 4-M-127(9 & 10) wadi walls, types LN01a and LN02b.






Figure M.18. Sites 4-M-157, 4-M-158 and 4-M-159 (scale 1:2500).




Plate M.63. Site 4-M-159(5), wall, type LN02b.




Plate M.64. Site 4-M-160(7), grave, type ~FM01.




Figure M.20. Site 4-L-167 (scale 1:1000).






Plate M.72. Site 4-M-169 looking along wall (5) to wall (1).






Plate M.73. Site 4-M-175, (13) and (13a).




Figure M.23. Site 4-M-183 to 4-M-188 (scale 1:500).




Figure M.24. Site 4-M-185 (scale 1:500).






Figure M.26. Site 4-M-196 (scale 1:500).






Plate M.80. Site 4-M-199(4), wall. type LN01a.
